International Wire payments are often delayed or misrouted because of inconsistent information between countries. One way to ensure that money is delivered to the intended destination as quickly as possible is to include the IBAN (International Bank Account Number) when sending foreign wires.

Below is a list of countries that will require IBAN numbers on all wire payments in 2007. Failure to include the IBAN number will result in penalty fees and returned wires. Please be sure to contact your beneficiaries to obtain the appropriate IBAN.
