 - National Bank of Oak Brook renamed First Oak Brook Bank 3/20/1973
 - First Oak Brook Bank renamed McDonald's Plaza Branch and became a branch of Oak Brook Bank 4/1/1988
- Acquired First Oak Brook Bank – DuPage (5762)
 - Warrenville State Bank was established as a non-member Bank (191542) 12/31/1959
 - Warrenville State Bank was renamed to Warrenville B&TC 2/11/1969
 - Warrenville B&TC was renamed to First Oak Brook Bank/DuPage 11/2/1984
 - First Oak Brook Bank/DuPage was renamed to Warrenville Branch and became a branch of Oak Brook Bank 4/1/1988
- Acquired 1st Oak Brook Bank (17316) 8/29/1994
 - Broadview-Westchester Bank was established as a non-member Bank (314837) 12/31/1959
 - Broadview-Westchester Bank was renamed to Broadview-Westchester State Bank 4/30/1973
 - Broadview-Westchester State Bank was renamed to Liberty Bank 10/19/1978
 - Liberty Bank was renamed to Oak Brook Bank/Liberty 3/15/1990
 - Oak Brook Bank/Liberty was renamed to 1st Oak Brook Bank 8/15/1991
 - 1st Oak Brook Bank was renamed to 2200 N. Waukegan Road OFF and changed from a non-member bank to a domestic branch of a domestic bank

 - Steel City National Bank of Chicago renamed to Steel City Bank of Chicago (8/17/93)
 - Steel City N.B. of Chicago renamed to Steel City National Bank of Chicago (12/28/79)
- Manufacturers Bank (14675) acquired U.S. Bank's charter 16230 (1995)
 - Manufacturers Charter 14675 became inactive and used U.S. Bank Charter 16230 and renamed Manufacturers Bank under 16230
- Mid-City National Bank of Chicago (3628) survivor of merger with Manufacturers (16230)

- Mid-City's Charter (3628) survives merger Manufacturers Charter (16230) 11/7/01

- Mid-City (3628) acquires Manufacturers Bank (16230) - 3628 charter survives merger of equals
- Mid-City National Bank of Chicago, the has been renamed MB Financial Bank, National Association 2001
